The Charleroi Area School District Education Foundation (CASDEF) is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization and a separate entity from the Charleroi Area School District (CASD). Our mission is to help raise funds to provide necessary resources/learning materials for the students and staff of the CASD.

The Covid-19 pandemic has not only created havoc within our own personal lives; but it, also, had a major impact on our schools, educators and students. For the 2022-2023 school year, the CASDEF is joining forces with the CASD to help raise monies to fund two major renovation projects.

This year, the CASD updated curriculum includes expanding the Industrial Arts & Engineering classes, which incorporates mechanical drawing, architecture and architectural engineering classes. In these courses, students need to use a plotter to print their projects. Whether it's an orthographic view of a mechanical part or the floor plan of a house, the plotter is used every day. Currently, the HP Plotter being used is very old and outdated. It can only accommodate 3-4 students per class period; making it difficult for students to print and work on projects in a timely manner. The current cost for a new HP Plotter, which will enable faster printing and allow all students to make their deadlines, is \$11,549.00. With Alumni support, we hope to fund this purchase and keep our school district moving forward with STEM oriented classes.

Our second renovation project is to help refurbish the Charleroi Area Middle School Greenhouse with updated irrigation system, electrical repairs, and supplies for cold weather planting to introduce new gardening methods and allow for use all year round. This project will work in partnership with Penn West University California, incorporating science, consumer science and health and wellness curriculums. Students from 6th to 12th grades will have the opportunity to grow a variety of plants, learn about healthy eating habits, create new recipes and learn about composting and alternative growing methods. The approximate cost for these updates is \$10,000.00.
